If you've ever imagined yourself deep in the Himalayas, lungs filled with crisp mountain air, eyes locked on the highest peak in the world, this is your time to make it real.

This fully planned Everest Base Camp trek covers every detail from the moment you touch down in Kathmandu: flights, hotels, refuges, meals, permits. All you need to bring is your determination, your curiosity, and your readiness for the adventure of a lifetime.

Over 15 days, you'll pass through rhododendron forests and highaltitude deserts, cross hanging suspension bridges, and share tea in tiny Sherpa villages. You'll stand inside ancient monasteries, listening to the low hum of chanting that has echoed through these mountains for generations. And one day, you'll arrive over the rocky ground of Base Camp at 5364m, Everest rising above you in all its raw, impressive beauty.

But what makes this trek different isn't just the destination — it's the experience. This is an adventure designed for connection, laughter, and moments you'll never see on a standard itinerary. Late-night music under a canopy of Himalayan stars. Shared meals that turn strangers into friends. That quiet moment on the trail when you look around and realize you're exactly where you're meant to be.

If Everest has ever been in your dreams, now is the time to make it real. The trail is ready. The mountains are waiting. And so are we.

Why this EBC trek is different

Most Everest Base Camp treks will get you to Base Camp.

Our trek will give you a story you'll still be telling years from now.

You'll be traveling with us - Renaud & Xavier - not as distant guides, but as part of the same journey. We'll hike together, share the highs and lows of each day, and be part of a tight-knit team. Our days won't just be about the miles we cover, they'll be filled with stories, laughter, and moments you can't script.

The group will be intentionally made up of people who share the same energy, curiosity, and goals. Evenings in the mountains might mean music by the fire (I'll have my guitar with me, and you're welcome to join me if you play an instrument yourself) or just relaxing in a lodge while the stars light up the sky. You'll meet people here who may become lifelong friends, the kind you'll plan future adventures with long after we've returned home. These are the memories that make a trip unforgettable, and they happen naturally when you're surrounded by the right people.

You may pay your deposit and balance using any lawful means. If sending money by electronic bank transfer, then you will be responsible for covering the cost of the fees associated with the transfer so that we receive the full amount shown on the invoice.

Cancellation

Should you decide to cancel your trip for any reason at any time between booking the trip and the start date of the trip, some deduction will be made to the advance amount. The following cancellation charges will apply if you decide to cancel the booking:

- Cancellations made 90 days or more before the start date will incur a loss of 33% of the deposit paid.
- Cancellations made between 90 days and 60 days before start date will incur a loss of 100% of the deposit paid.
- Cancellations made between 60 days and 30 days before start date will incur a loss of 50% of the full trip cost.
- Cancellations made between 30 days and start of trip or at any time during trip will incur a loss of 100% of the full trip cost.

For all cancellations, the company must be notified in writing. Acceptable means of communication include letter and email.
